The Vineyard

The name Monistrol comes from the Latin word “Monasteriola”, a small monastery that was built on the banks of the Anoia River during the early Middle Ages. During the 16th century 40 farmers dedicated themselves to cultivating the rich vineyards surrounding this vast, Romanesque structure. In the centuries to follow the vineyards were expanded and in 1882, the Marquis of Monistrol, dedicated part of the vintage to sparkling wine using the “champenoise” traditional method. Today Marques de Monistrol is set in the heart of the Penedes Region, surrounded by over 1000 acres that constitute the largest vineyard in the district of Sant Sadurni d’ Anoia.

Harvest & Ageing

"Masía" means "farmhouse" in Catalonia, an area renowned for its style and Mediterranean elegance. Masía wines are a true reflection of this region and represent an outstanding wine value. The white wine is made from the prime grape must of the Chardonnay and Macabeo grapes and fermented in stainless steel tanks at low temperature.

Winemaker's Notes

This straw colored wine with a soft, golden hue has a fruity, flowery bouquet. The palate is fresh and dry with a long elegant finish of fruit.

Appellation: Penedés

Finished Alcohol: 11.5%
